PASTORATE MISSION:

We encourage everyone to attend our two-day Lenten mission, **March 8 & 9**. Each evening will have two great speakers who will help us grow in our faith along with times to pray together. Please consider blocking out time to join us for these special evenings. We will do all we can to make them worth your effort to be there. No registration is needed - please just come and pray with us.

- **Evening 1, Sunday Mar 8th: Focus – GODS GRACE** On this night we will gather **in the church at Resurrection** at 6:30pm. We will have a talk by Ms. Haley Scott Dimaria, a nationally known speaker about how Jesus and His grace have been active in her own life journey. After her talk we will have time for questions and discussion and a short break. Then we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament with beautiful music from 8-8:30pm.
- **Evening 2, Monday Mar 9th: Focus - MERCY NIGHT.** On this night we will gather **at the church at St. Paul** at 7pm. We will have a talk by Fr. Chuck Canterna who has spent decades ministering in prisons. Fr. I, Fr. Andy, heard Fr. Chuck talk at my previous assignment for a parish retreat and was blown away by his message. I highly recommend coming to hear Fr. Chuck speak about HOW TO RECEIVE AND GIVE the gift of God’s love and mercy in our lives. Fr. Chuck will end at 7:45pm. Then we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and will say the rosary together and close with Benediction 7:50- 8:20pm.

DAYS OF GIVING UP MEAT & FASTING

On Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays in Lent, Catholics are asked to give up meat. Also, on Ash Wednesdays and Good Friday, Catholics from age 18 through 59, are asked to fast by having one full meal and two lighter meals those days with no eating between meals.
