Theme - Solidarity

Summary: The Gospel calls us to be our sisters' and brothers' keepers, everywhere in the world; we must be dedicated to the common good. Solidarity with all God's people means that we see every person as part of our community and therefore our concern. At the core of the virtue of solidarity is the pursuit of justice and peace. While it is important to give to ministries that assist the poor and vulnerable, we must also be attuned to their struggles and advocate on their behalf.

From the USCCB statement about the current surge of immigration enforcement: "no one can turn a deaf ear to the palpable cries of anxiety and fear heard in communities throughout the country in the wake of a surge in immigration enforcement actions."
