Guidelines for Receiving Holy Communion

Words of Remembrance/Eulogy:_

In order to receive Holy Communion, one must be a practicing Catholic, not be conscious of any grave sin not remitted by a priest in the sacrament of Penance, and have fasted for one hour. Anyone not receiving Holy Communion, including people of other religions, may come forward at communion time to receive a blessing, indicated by folding one's arms across one's chest.
